ECHO Intellectual and/or Developmental Disabilities (IDD) Wraparound connects community health care providers and children and young adults with IDD with behavioral health specialists.

WHAT YOU GAIN:

- Learn and apply a **functional behavioral model** for **assessment and treatment of disruptive behaviors and skill deficits**.
